"54% of junior pupils attend 1 or more clubs (43 out of 79 pupils)"

"35% of pupils attend 1 or more school clubs across the whole school (44 pupils out of 125)"

- Lunchtime clubs are currently offered to junior pupils only due to staffing ratios/1:1 support requirements of infant department
- Infant pupils offered a range of adult supported activities during playtimes
- Take up for after school clubs is often low due to parent transport/pick up difficulties
- Infant after school club due to start after Christmas to provide infant pupils with club opportunity. Club was offered Autumn 2016 to parents but poor response/take up.
