



Communication & Language:

I am learning:

- to listen to stories with more attention and recall.
- to respond to simple instructions.
- to use words focused on objects and people that are importance to me.
- to listen and do for a short time.
- to follow a story without pictures or props.
- to link statements and stick to a main theme or intention.
- to participate in discussions, performances and role play.
- to listen to adults and my friends.
- to give descriptions, explanations and narratives for different purposes, including for expressing feelings.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development:

I am learning:

- to initiate play and ask my friends to join me.
- to enjoy responsibility of carrying out small tasks.
- to take turns and share resources.
- to explain what I know and ask people questions.
- to describe myself and the things I can do
- that my actions affect other people, e.g. upset or tries to comfort another child when they realise they have upset them.
- to play co-operatively and take turns with others.
- to be confident in trying new activities
- that some behaviour is unacceptable.

Understanding the World

I am learning:

- to show interest in the lives of people who I know.
- to ask questions and talk about the world I know e.g. the place where I live or the natural world.
- that information can be retrieved from computers.
- to enjoy joining in with family customs and routines.
- to look closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change.
- to complete a simple program on the computer.
- to talk about past and present events in my life and in the lives of my family.
- to recognise that a range of technology in my home and school

Expressive Arts & Design

I am learning:

- to enjoy joining in with dancing and ring games.
- to use available resources to create props to support role-play.
- to select appropriate resources.
- to create simple representations of events, people and objects.
- to sing songs and make music.
- to use what I have learnt about media and materials in new ways

Physical Development:

I am learning:

- to mount stairs, steps or climbing equipment using alternate feet.
- to tell adults when I am hungry or tired, when I want to rest or play.
- to wash and dry hands.
- to form some recognisable letters.
- to stay dry and clean during the day.
- to handle equipment and tools effectively, including pencils for writing.
- how important exercise is for good health.

Mathematics

I am learning:

- to use some number names accurately in play.
- to say numbers in order to 10.
- to talk about the shapes of everyday objects, e.g. 'round' and 'tall'
- to counts up to three or four objects by saying one number name for each item.
- to recognise some numerals of personal significance.
- to use mathematical names for 3D and 2D shapes, and mathematical terms to describe them.
- to order and sequence familiar events.
- to count, read and write numbers to 30 in numerals
- to read and understand a number sentence which has +, - and = signs
- to recognise and know the value of different coins - 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p
- to recognise and name 2-D shapes.

Literacy

I am learning:

- to guess how the story might end.
- to look at books on my own and carefully.
- to say what I have drawn or painted.
- to hear and say the initial sound in words.
- that information can be retrieved from books and computers.
- to write short sentences in meaningful contexts.
- apply phonic knowledge to help me decode words.
- to re-read books to help me become confident in reading.
- to recognise and join in with predictable phrases.
- to name the letters of the alphabet.
- to composing a sentence orally before writing it
