As accounting officer the headteacher of Woolgrove School Special Needs Academy has responsibility for ensuring that the academy trust delivers good value in the use of public resources. The Governing Body is accountable for the way in which the school's resources are allocated to meet the objectives set out in our School Development Plan. The Governing Body approve the annual budget and receive and approve the external auditors' management report and take action on any recommendations made by them following the annual audit. The finance Committee meets termly to review the budget monitoring reports and to approve larger expenditure items and compliance with the academies statement of internal financial control. Recommendations will be put to the termly Governing Body Meeting.

Contracts are regularly reviewed to ensure best value.

The Academy carefully monitors pupils progress to ensure resources are targeted appropriately and pupil premium expenditure is assessed to show effectiveness in improving the attainment of students on Free School Meals and Looked After Children.

Resources are directed where they are most needed and most effective in meeting education requirements. Resources have been targeted to provide individual support to pupils with language difficulties, specific learning difficulties and in need of sensory support.

The Academy will continue to monitor the impact of changes to Special Educational Needs funding and to maintain pupil numbers in order to secure annual funding.
