Additional Activities & Charging Policy

The School has its own minibuses and classes are frequently taken out on local trips. Most of these are free. Voluntary contributions may also be requested for longer trips or where the activity requires an entrance fee. However, pupils are never prevented from joining in an activity if parents feel unable to contribute. If insufficient voluntary contributions are raised to fund a visit, then it may be cancelled.

The Items for which charges are made are listed below:-

Milk	Free for all Infant Pupils. Junior Pupils are currently charged 20p per day on a monthly basis.	All Infant Pupils and Junior Pupils who wish to pay. Pupils on free school meals are entitled to free school milk.	
School Meals	All Infant pupils are entitled to Universal Free School Meals (UFSM) Junior pupils are charged £2.40 per day or £12 weekly. This is under review and may be increased in April.	All pupils attending the school.	Pupils on free school meals pay nothing. It is parents responsibility to make an online claim if they feel they may be eligible for FSM.
Visits/Journeys	This depends on the nature of the trip.	No child is barred from any trip which is part of the curriculum for the class.	
Holidays	Wymondley Woods. A weeklong residential trip is held annually in the summer term for year 6 pupils. The cost of the trip is reviewed annually.	Offered to all year 6 Pupils.	A staged payment plan is offered to parents. Parents with concerns regarding costs are invited to contact the headteacher. Woolgrove do not wish any child to be disadvantaged due to financial hardship.
Swimming	Free. Reviewed annually.	All pupils have swimming lessons at least once a week for half of every term.	The Governing body will review the provision of free swimming lessons annually in the summer term, for the next financial year.
Horse Riding	Free	Offered to all children for at least a term in their school career.	This is reviewed each year, subsidised by The Friends of Woolgrove.
Uniform	Current prices for sweatshirts, polo shirts, T-shirts, cardigans and hats can be obtained from the office	All pupils are entitled to wear the school uniform.	Parents who prefer not to buy the uniform are asked to keep to the school colours of red, white and grey.
Cooking	Each class arranges to collect the amount needed to cover the ingredients for cookery lessons.	All pupils have some cooking lessons each term.	
Snacks	Each of the classes ask for contributions or collects money towards playtime snacks.	All the children in the class will share the food and drink.	Older pupils are allowed to bring healthy snacks to eat during playtime.
Clubs Yoga & Karate	These lunchtime clubs are currently paid from the PE Premium. This policy will be reviewed annually.	Karate club for pupils Years 4 and above. Yoga for pupils Years 3 and above. Numbers are limited.	
Clubs	After school clubs are provided with charges reflecting the individual resources and staffing requirements.	Infant Club offered to all infants. Cookery club for pupils Year 4 and above and Environment Club for Years 3 and above.	Parents are encouraged to approach the school if they feel financial hardship may prevent their child from attending.

Where a charge and voluntary contribution has been requested and an excess income has been received an offer of a refund is made, if over £1 per head. Less than this amount is to be spent on the children on the relevant trip.
