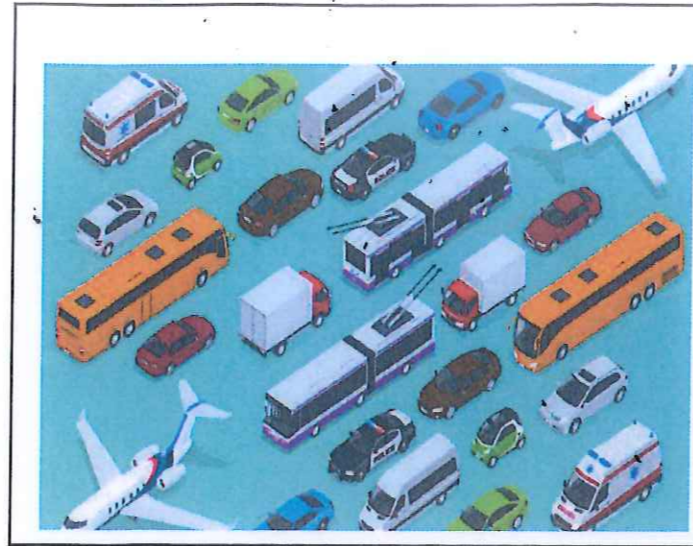




Understanding of the World –

The children will be thinking about different types of transport that are used on land, on water and in the air. They will go on to explore materials used for different purposes as well as investigating objects that float and sink. They will be thinking about their own experiences of using different types of transport and about holidays they may have been on in the past.

Getting Around Sphere Class Spring Term

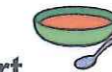


PSHE- Belonging to Groups
