## Mini Police Project

Last week saw a number of our classes complete their Mini-Police project, during which they have learned about many aspects of police work including road safety, and keeping safe online. The interactive sessions have been really positive and the children were awarded certificates for successfully completing the sessions.



# **Hungry Caterpillar**

Our EYFS children took part in a promoting 'healthy food' activity organised by our catering providers, Herts Catering. It was based on the Hungry Caterpillar book and involved the children helping to prepare and sample a variety of healthy snacks. This is one of a number of planned initiatives aimed at providing the children with fun activities which allow them to explore healthy food alternatives.

# **Expressive Art and Design Update**

This term we have been fortunate to have John Lavelle from Hertfordshire Music Service in to work with a group of our children. This has given them the opportunity to explore and begin to learn the basics of how to play the tenor horn. The singers from our Formal classes started rehearsing in October and are busy preparing songs ready for performances near the end of term. Our other singing groups have now started rehearsing on a Thursday morning and are bringing together a number of children from different classes. We have been pleased to see the lovely art work this week that the children have created to enter into the Hertfordshire Heroes Christmas Art competition.

## Jack and the Beanstalk

A number of our classes were treated to a wonderful performance of Jack and the Beanstalk. The production was put on by



M&M productions and this was funded by the Happy Days charity which uses a variety of donors. We had over 66 pupils watch the show and so many of them loved it. The laughter could be heard from well beyond our school hall. Throughout the day children were talking about the show and sharing their thoughts, highlighting its value in providing both fun and a perfect opportunity to promote communication, one of our learning priorities.

#### **Christmas Bazaar**

On Thursday 14th December in the afternoon we will be holding a Christmas Bazaar at school. Each class will have their own stall with the children deciding what they will sell or have on their stall.
