My role as Family Support Worker (FSW), a member of the Senior Leadership Team and a Deputy Designated Safeguarding Lead (DDSL), makes me a link between home and school. I work closely with families and teachers to ensure the best outcomes for all children. This includes attending meetings with professionals to support families with any issues

- Supporting families e.g. with behaviour strategies in the home
- Signposting to agencies, courses and respite
- Regular check in calls and being a listening ear to Woolgrove families

DDSL:

- Attending TAF/CIN meetings to support families

Transport:

I work closely with County Transport, who accept and allocate our transport applications.

- Assisting with transport applications
- Liaise with County transport and providers
- Ensuring a safe meet and greet for children between school and home (mornings and afternoons)
- Provide visual aids to help children prepare for new transport

Medical:

- Ensure Individual Health Care Plans (IHCP) are accurate and up to date for pupil medical needs including medical permissions
- Support parents/carers with referrals e.g. special needs dentist
